40	STATEMENT OF FACT
42	This amendment changes the original bill to allow a municipality to audit a commercial hazardous waste facility
44	within its jurisdiction to ensure compliance with any local ordinances that may levy fees on the facility based on that
46	facility's annual billings. It removes authority from the Commissioner of Environmental Postection to audit the facility
48	for this purpose. The amendment also removes a retroactivity clause and adds a fiscal note to the bill.
