HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 594,
L.D. 845, Bill, "An Act to Reduce Marine Pollution"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 5 by striking
out all of paragraph A (page 2, lines 1 to 8 in amendment) and
inserting in its place the following:

'A. The commissioner, upon presentation of credentials, may
enter privately owned land at reasonable times with the
owner's permission. If entry to the land is denied by the
owner, the commissioner may seek a search warrant to inspect
the land for sources of pollution under this section. A
warrant may not be issued to search a domicile or
residential building or ancillary structures; and'
