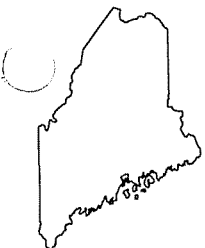

A consumer who has purchased a new automobile that by law is
considered a "lemon" is entitled to receive either a replacement
16 vehicle or a refund. This bill entitles the consumer to receive
not only the return of the purchase price or, if a leased
18 vehicle, the lease payments made to date, but also any finance
charges paid by the consumer.

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
