Vulnerable Families.**

(EMERGENCY)

2 approximately 500 families per year. A family with a child at
3 risk of unnecessary or inappropriate out-of-home placement is
4 eligible for the service. Children who are ordinarily subject to
5 out-of-home placement are able to remain in the family in a
6 nurturing environment. This bill ensures that the safety net for
7 families provided through home-based family services is available.
