38	This bill transfers the head injury registry from the Bureau
40	of Rehabilitation to the Bureau of Health within the Department of Human Services. The Bureau of Health has indicated it will
42	require an additional appropriation of \$15,000 annually for a part-time Clerk Typist II position and related costs. The
44	transfer of this function does not warrant the requested level of funding and could be implemented within budgeted resources.'

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## STATEMENT OF FACT

The amendment replaces the original bill. It moves the 6 registry of persons who sustain head injuries from the Bureau of Rehabilitation to the Bureau of Health within the Department of 8 Human Services. The amendment also adds a fiscal note.
