SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 326, L.D. 882, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Laws Concerning Certification of Educational Personnel"

Amend the amendment in section 14 by inserting at the end the following:

**Block Grants to Municipalities**

All Other (\$1,770,000) (\$1,770,000)

Provides for the deappropriation of funds for municipalities for local school educator certification costs.
