COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 619, L.D. 889, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Rules Dealing with Laundering Services for Cloth Diapers Used by Day Care Centers"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §8302, sub-§3, as enacted by PL 1989, c. 723, is repealed.

Sec. 2. 22 MRSA §8302, sub-§4 is enacted to read:

4. Rules regarding cloth diapers. The commissioner shall adopt rules regarding the use of cloth diapers in licensed day care facilities and registered home baby-sitting services.

FISCAL NOTE

This bill amends the rules dealing with cloth diapers. The Department of Human Services will absorb the costs associated with amending its rules and monitoring compliance with the rules within budgeted resources.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment replaces the original bill. It repeals the current requirement that allows the use of cloth diapers if a diaper laundering service is used and replaces it with a requirement that rules be adopted by the Department of Human Services that address the use of diapers in licensed day care facilities and registered home baby-sitting services.
