3. Approval of laundering services. The rules must allow the use of cloth diapers in -a- day care facility-if-the-facility employs-a-diaper-laundering-service facilities. The-rules-must require-that-the-diaper-laundering-service-be-endorsed-by-a national-accrediting-organization-and-must-specify-the-type-of diaper-eovers-that-must-be-used-

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STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill removes the restriction that a day care facility may only use cloth diapers if the facility employs a diaper laundering service.
