HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 620,
L.D. 890, Bill, "An Act to Require the Department of Human
Services to Have a Regular Presence in Every County of the State"

Amend the amendment by striking out sections 1 to 3 and
inserting in their place the following:

Sec. 1. Human services; Lincoln and Oxford counties. In
addition to other offices of the Department of Human Services
providing intake services existing on the effective date of this
Act, if office space is provided at no charge to the department,
the department shall establish and maintain an office in Lincoln
County and one in Oxford County for intake services. The
departmental staff of these offices must include, but is not
limited to, public health nurses, food stamp workers, other
income maintenance program workers and vocational rehabilitation
workers. The department shall provide the necessary equipment
for the offices. The offices may be maintained on an itinerant
basis but must provide services on at least a regular biweekly
basis.

Sec. 2. Report. The Department of Human Services shall submit
a report by November 1, 1993 to the joint standing committee of
the Legislature having jurisdiction over human resources matters
and the joint standing committee of the Legislature having
jurisdiction over appropriations and financial affairs. This
report must include:

1. The number of Department of Human Services' physical
sites in each county;

2. The number of staff hours and hours of operation at each
site;

3. The number of people served at each site; and
