An Act to Cover Replacement Vehicle Costs.



2 14 MRSA §1454, as amended by PL 1989, c. 623, is further amended to read:

### \$1454. Cost of replacement motor vehicles

In any action where recovery is sought for the destruction or damage of a motor vehicle, the owner of such motor vehicle shall—be is entitled to recover reasonable rental costs actually expended for a replacement motor vehicle during such time,—net—to exceed—45—days, as the damaged motor vehicle could not be operated or during such time,—net—to—exceed—45—days, as is required to obtain a replacement motor vehicle for the destroyed motor vehicle.

Current law provides for the recovery of the cost of replacement motor vehicles for a period of up to 45 days. This bill removes the 45-day limitation and provides that the motor vehicle owner is entitled to recover reasonable rental costs actually expended for a replacement vehicle during the time that the damaged vehicle can not be operated.
