Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

5. Service in Armed Forces. Service credit for service in the United States Armed Forces is governed by Title 5, sections 17655, 17713, 17760. For purposes of this section a member is considered to have begun membership on the earliest of: the date the member became a member of the Maine Judicial Retirement System; the beginning date of the member's prior service; or the date the member became a member of the Maine State Retirement System.

This bill allows a member of the judiciary to include service in the United States Armed Forces as creditable service for purposes of the retirement laws.
