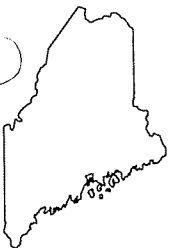

NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE

An Act to Amend the Maine Judicial Retirement System Laws.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2
4 MRSA §1302, sub-§5 is enacted to read:

4
6 5. Service in Armed Forces. Service credit for service in
8 the United States Armed Forces is governed by Title 5, sections
10 17655, 17713, 17760. For purposes of this section a member is
12 considered to have begun membership on the earliest of: the date
14 the member became a member of the Maine Judicial Retirement
16 System; the beginning date of the member's prior service; or the
18 date the member became a member of the Maine State Retirement
20 System.

STATEMENT OF FACT

16 This bill allows a member of the judiciary to include
18 service in the United States Armed Forces as creditable service
for purposes of the retirement laws.
