## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

39 MRSA §52, first ¶, as amended by PL 1981, c. 93, is further 4 amended to read:

An employee sustaining a personal injury arising out of and 6 in the course of his employment or is disabled by occupational disease shall-be is entitled to reasonable and proper medical, or 8 and hospital services, nursing, medicines, and surgical mechanical, or surgical aids, as needed, paid for by the 10 employer. A pharmacist or medical provider shall use generic 12 drugs in dispensing medicines. An injured employee shall-havehas the right to make his the employee's own selection of a physician or surgeon authorized to practice as such under the 14 laws of the State. The injured employee may make the initial 16 selection and subsequently may change physician or surgeon once without approval from a commissioner. If the injured employee selects another physician or surgeon after the subsequent change, 18 the insurer or self-insured employer may require approval from a commissioner. 20

## STATEMENT OF FACT

26 This bill realizes workers' compensation cost savings by requiring the use of generic drugs and by limiting 28 overutilization associated with the practice of doctor shopping.
