COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 636, L.D. 906, Bill, "An Act to Amend Certain Commercial Motor Vehicle Laws"

Amend the bill in section 3 in subsection 1 in the first paragraph in the 4th and 5th lines (page 1, lines 26 and 27 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "section 246-A" and inserting in its place the following: 'sections 245 and 245-A'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 7. Allocation. The following funds are allocated from the Highway Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

APPROPRIATIONS/ALLOCATIONS

Highway Fund \$61,982

REVENUES

Highway Fund \$250,000

The Division of Motor Vehicles will require a Highway Fund allocation of \$61,982 in fiscal year 1992-93 to enter into the International Registration Plan. This allocation will provide funds for a Clerk Typist II position for the 4th quarter of fiscal year 1992-93, a computer workstation and general operating expenses.

The increase of certain fees within the International Registration Plan program will increase Highway Fund revenue by \$250,000 in fiscal year 1992-93 and \$126,000 annually beginning in fiscal year 1993-94, based on 250,000 nonresident vehicles participating in the International Registration Program.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment corrects a section of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 29 erroneously cited in the bill. The amendment also adds an allocation and a fiscal note.
