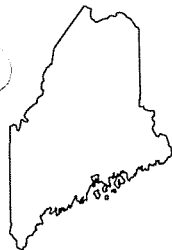

**An Act to Clarify the Funding of Child Care Services and Parenting
Education.**



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

20-A MRSA §6651, sub-§3-A is enacted to read:

3-A. Subsidizable costs of community-based agencies under the School Finance Act of 1985. The cost of services as calculated in subsection 3 that were funded and administered by a nonprofit community-based agency in school years 1989-90 and 1990-91 is subsidizable as program costs under the School Finance Act of 1985 if:

A. The services were otherwise provided in conformity with this subchapter; and

B. The school administrative unit has made a commitment to administer and fund the services starting in 1991-92.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill allows a school administrative unit that takes over child care and parenting education services developed by a nonprofit community-based agency in conformity with the provisions of Public Law 1987, chapter 767, "An Act to Provide for Child Care and Child Development Training for Student Parents" to include the cost of the service expended by the community agency as subsidizable costs under the School Finance Act of 1985. This provision only applies to the calculation of state aid for schools to be received in school years 1991-92 and 1992-93.
