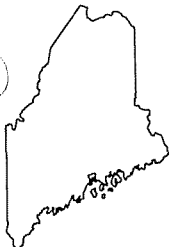

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**An Act to Amend the Campaign Finance Reporting Laws.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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21-A MRSA §1051, first ¶, as amended by PL 1989, c. 833, §12,  
is further amended to read:

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This subchapter applies to the activities of political  
action committees ~~organized in this State~~ that accept  
contributions, incur obligations or make expenditures in an  
aggregate amount in excess of \$50 in any one calendar year for  
the election of state or county officers in this State, or for  
the support or defeat of any campaign, as defined in this  
subchapter.

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#### STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill amends the campaign finance reporting law by  
deleting language limiting the application of the law to  
political action committees organized in this State.
