IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE

An Act to Amend the Campaign Finance Reporting Laws.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

21-A MRSA §1051, first ¶, as amended by PL 1989, c. 833, §12, is further amended to read:

This subchapter applies to the activities of political action committees erganized---in---this---State that accept contributions, incur obligations or make expenditures in an aggregate amount in excess of \$50 in any one calendar year for the election of state or county officers in this State, or for the support or defeat of any campaign, as defined in this subchapter.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill amends the campaign finance reporting law by deleting language limiting the application of the law to political action committees organized in this State.
