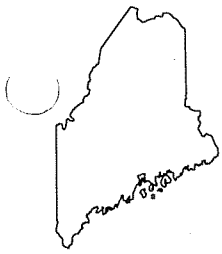

An Act Regarding the Location of State Agency Stores.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §453, sub-§1, ¶C, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 45, Pt. A, §4, is amended to read:

C. The proposed agency liquor store is not within 10 miles of an existing state liquor store ~~ex-agency-liquor-store~~.

Sec. 2. 28-A MRSA §453, sub-§1, ¶D is enacted to read:

D. The commission may grant more than one agency liquor store license in a town when the commission determines it appropriate.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill allows the State Liquor Commission to locate more than one agency liquor store in a town not serviced by a state liquor store.
