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**An Act to Make Allocations from the Public Utilities Commission  
Regulatory Fund and the Public Utilities Commission Reimbursement  
Fund for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1992 and June 30, 1993.**

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(EMERGENCY)

2           **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not  
become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted  
as emergencies; and

6           Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate until after the  
beginning of the next fiscal year; and

8           Whereas, certain obligations and expenses incident to the  
operation of the Public Utilities Commission will become due and  
payable on or immediately after July 1, 1991; and

12           Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts  
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of  
Maine and require the following legislation as immediately  
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and  
safety; now, therefore,

18           Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

20           **Sec. 1. Allocation of the Public Utilities Commission Regulatory**  
**Fund.** Income to the Public Utilities Commission Regulatory Fund  
22 for the next 2 fiscal years, from July 1, 1991 to June 30, 1992  
and from July 1, 1992 to June 30, 1993, must be segregated,  
24 apportioned and disbursed as designated in the following schedule.
