COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 340, L.D. 930, Bill, "An Act to Clarify the Certification of Correspondence Schools"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

This bill clarifies the certificate-of-approval process of the Department of Education for privately owned postsecondary correspondence schools and increases the certification fee. There are currently 6 such schools and, if they renew their certification, an increase in General Fund revenues of \$150 annually will result.'
