## COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 359, L.D. 961

This bill will affect one judge allowing that judge to
retire 1 1/2 years early. This change will increase the unfunded
actuarial reserve of the Maine Judicial Retirement System by
approximately \$34,000. The annual amortization payments will be
\$1,600. The Judicial Department will require additional General
Fund appropriations of \$1,200 in fiscal year 1991-92 and \$1,600
in fiscal year 1992-93 to fund these increased employer
contributions.'
