## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE

An Act to Ensure Timely and Equitable Treatment of Discrimination Complaints Made to the Maine Ĥuman Rights Commission.

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#### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

5 MRSA §4612, sub-§3, as amended by PL 1985, c. 585, §2, is further amended to read:

Informal methods; conciliation. If the commission finds б 3. reasonable grounds to believe that unlawful discrimination has 8 occurred, but finds no emergency of the sort contemplated in subsection 4, paragraph B, it the commission shall endeavor to eliminate such that discrimination by informal means such as 10 conference, conciliation and persuasion. Nothing said or done as part of such endeavors may be made public without the written 12 consent of the parties to the proceeding, nor used as evidence in 14 any subsequent proceeding, civil or criminal, except in a civil action alleging a breach of agreement filed by the commission or a party. If the case is disposed of by such informal means in a 16 manner satisfactory to a majority of the commission, it the commission shall dismiss the proceeding. If the case is not 18 disposed of under this subsection within 60 days of the 20 commission's receipt of the complaint, the commission shall file a civil action under subsection 4, paragraph A.

### STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill establishes a time frame for the informal conciliation efforts in employment discrimination cases as mandated by Maine Human Rights Commission laws. Time frames are routinely employed in mediation and arbitration procedures to ensure that the informal negotiation process is not abused by either party.

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
