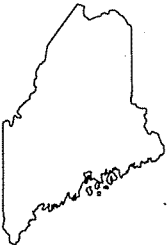

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 12 MRSA §7406, sub-§12, as amended by PL 1985, c. 304, §16,
is further amended to read:

6 12. Hunting without hunter orange clothing. A person is
guilty of hunting without hunter orange clothing if he the hunter
8 hunts with firearms during the open firearm season on deer any
wildlife and fails to wear an article of solid-colored hunter
10 orange hunter clothing which that is in good and serviceable
condition and which that is visible from all sides, ~~except that~~
12 ~~persons hunting waterfowl from a beat or blind or in conjunction~~
~~with waterfowl decoys need not wear hunter orange clothing.~~

18 This bill requires that hunters wear solid-colored orange
clothing in all hunting seasons for any wildlife.
