SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 365, L.D. 967, Bill, "An Act Proposing a License Cap to Manage the Lobster Fishing Effort Through the Limited Issuance of Licenses"

Amend the amendment by striking out everything after the first paragraph after the title and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'An Act to Eliminate the Lobster Management Task Force'

Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. PL 1991, c. 528, Pt. B, §1, under that part designated "LEGISLATURE," that part relating to "Lobster Management Task Force" is repealed.

Sec. 2. PL 1991, c. 528, Pt. B, §1, under that part designated "LEGISLATURE," last line is amended to read:
