COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 367, L.D. 969, "Resolve, Authorizing the State Tax Assessor to Convey the Interest of the State in Certain Real Estate in the Unorganized Territory"

Amend the bill by inserting after the title the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the 90-day period could delay or prevent the timely sale of the following parcels; and

Whereas, an early and orderly sale of these parcels would ensure continued efficient administration of the State's property tax responsibilities; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it'

Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve takes effect when approved.

FISCAL NOTE

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Any funds received through sales of these parcels in an amount above the amount of taxes due will be placed in the Unorganized Territory Educational and Services Fund. The amount of additional dedicated revenue will depend on the prices received for the parcels.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment adds an emergency preamble, emergency clause and a fiscal note.
