IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE

An Act to Clarify Certain Provisions of the Lien Laws.



Be it	enacted	by	the	People	of	the	State	of	Maine	as	follows:
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10 MRSA §3251, as amended by PL 1971, c. 421, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

§3251. Lièn established

A person who provides materials, labor or services that add value to real or personal property, whether by virtue of a contract with or with the consent of the owner of the property, has a lien on the property and on any interest the owner has in the property to secure payment for the materials, labor or services.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The existing lien laws provide a statutory lien for certain specific individuals under specific conditions. The bill provides a legal remedy to any person who provides materials, labor or services to materially benefit the personal or real property of another and is not compensated.
