HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 688, L.D. 987, Bill, "An Act to Allow the Department of Transportation to Facilitate Traffic and Highway Improvements"

Amend the bill in section 3 by striking out all of the last underlined sentence (page 1, lines 40 to 43 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following: 'Notwithstanding the Maine Tort Claims Act, Title 14, chapter 741, the State or its employees are immune from suit for damages arising from any activities performed in connection with this work.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify that this bill grants immunity notwithstanding the Maine Tort Claims Act.
