Purchase or cost of construction of portable, temporary classroom space as approved by the commissioner beginning 1988. For the purposes of this section, "portable, temporary classroom space" means a project consisting of one or more mobile or modular buildings that are at least partially constructed off site and are designed to be moved to other sites with a minimum of disassembly and reassembly. "Portable, temporary classroom space" includes, but is not limited to, space for regular classrooms, small group instruction, libraries, clinics and quidance and administrative office space, including principal superintendent offices. The amount includable determining the subsidy for a school administrative unit for the purchase or construction of portable temporary classroom space shall may not exceed the amount that would have been paid for lease of a comparable classroom. The department shall adopt rules for approving the purchase, construction or lease-purchase of portable temporary classroom space, and for determining the amount includable for subsidy purposes. Approved costs shall-be are those for the year prior to the year of allocation.'
