Before approving a funding 40 source, the Legislative Council shall examine whether accepting funds from this source will risk the appearance of undue 42 influence or actual undue influence on the study. If the Legislative Council determines that accepting funds from the 44 source will cause this risk, the Legislative Council may not approve the funding source. The Legislative Council shall 46 administer any outside funds acquired for the conduct of the 48 study. Administration of these funds includes authorizing the Executive Director of the Legislative Council to approve or disapprove any contract for assistance to the study in accordance 50 with guidelines adopted by the Legislative Council.
