SENATE AMENDMENT " A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 374, L.D. 999, Bill, "An Act to Establish the Maine Primary Care Residency Training Assistance Program"

Amend the amendment in section 5 in subsection 3 in the 4th and 5th lines (page 3, lines 24 and 25 in amendment) by striking out the following: "February 15, 1992" and inserting the following: 'November 1, 1991'

Further amend the amendment in section 5 in subsection 3 in the 6th and 7th lines (page 3, lines 26 and 27 in amendment) by striking out the following: "February 15, 1993" and inserting the following: 'November 1, 1992'

Further amend the amendment in section 5 in subsection 4 in the first line (page 3, line 29 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "available" the following: 'and subject to subsection 6'

Further amend the bill in section 5 by striking out all of subsection 6 and inserting in its place the following:

'6. The Legislative Council may seek outside sources of funding to finance the activities of the commission. The Legislative Council may authorize the commission to develop funding proposals. The Executive Director of the Legislative Council shall review and approve any proposal before its submission to a funding source. Before approving a funding source, the Legislative Council shall examine whether accepting funds from this source will risk the appearance of undue influence or actual undue influence on the study. If the Legislative Council determines that accepting funds from the source will cause this risk, the Legislative Council may not approve the funding source. The Legislative Council shall administer any outside funds acquired for the conduct of the study. Administration of these funds includes authorizing the Executive Director of the Legislative Council to approve or disapprove any contract for assistance to the study in accordance with guidelines adopted by the Legislative Council. Expenditures may not be incurred that have an impact on the General Fund. Expenditures may not be incurred for the commission unless outside sources of funding have been received by the Legislative Council.'


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SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 374,

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STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment amends Committee Amendment "A" by changing the reporting date of the Primary Care Residency Commission, if funding is received, from February 15, 1992 to November 1, 1991 and if no funding is received, from February 15, 1993 to November 1, 1992. This amendment also makes any proposal for outside funding subject to review and approval by the Executive Director of the Legislative Council. The amendment also adds language that gives the Legislative Council the authority to disapprove a funding source if there is a risk that accepting the funds will cause undue influence on the study.
