An Act to Preserve Public Ownership of Historic Fort Gorges in Casco Bay.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 P&SL 1983, c. 70, sub-§3 is enacted to read:

6 3. Sale price. The City of Portland shall convey Fort
8 Gorges to the State for the sum of \$1 plus the actual cost of any
improvements made to Fort Gorges by the City of Portland not paid
for by charitable, state or federal funds.

10 STATEMENT OF FACT

12 This bill sets the price the State shall pay for Fort
14 Gorges, should the City of Portland determine to sell it.
16 Existing state law already gives the State right of first
purchase refusal.
