An Act to Establish Special Designating Registration Plates for Vietnam Veterans of the Tet Offensive.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 29 MRSA §252-H is enacted to read:

6 §252-H. Tet Offensive veterans; special license plates

8 The Secretary of State, on application and upon evidence of
10 payment of the excise tax required by Title 36, section 1482,
12 shall issue registration certificates and special designating
14 plates for use in lieu of regular registration plates to persons
16 who served in the United States Armed Forces and who were
18 stationed in Vietnam during the Tet Offensive. Each application
20 must be accompanied by appropriate military certification
22 verifying the applicant's service in Vietnam during the Tet
24 Offensive. This special license plate is issued specifically to
veterans of the Tet Offensive and the privilege of using the
special plate is not transferable.

20 STATEMENT OF FACT

22 This bill allows veterans who were stationed in Vietnam
24 during the Tet Offensive to have a special license plate.
