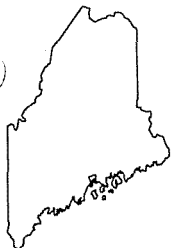

An Act Relating to Funds Appropriated for Capital Projects.



2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **5 MRSA §1753 is enacted to read:**

6 **§1753. Capital project funding**

8 All funds appropriated for capital projects must be
10 appropriated to the Department of Administration and expended by
the Bureau of Public Improvements pursuant to a review process
established by rule.

12 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

16 At this time, when funds for capital projects are
18 appropriated by a specific department, the project may go ahead
20 without the appropriate controls, such as site planning and
engineering review, or a project may be delayed. This bill would
put all capital projects under the review process established by
the Department of Administration, Bureau of Public Improvements.
