Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 5 MRSA §1753 is enacted to read: 4 §1753. Capital project funding б All funds appropriated for capital projects must be appropriated to the Department of Administration and expended by 8 the Bureau of Public Improvements pursuant to a review process 10 established by rule. 12 STATEMENT OF FACT 14 At this time, when funds for capital projects are 16 appropriated by a specific department, the project may go ahead without the appropriate controls, such as site planning and engineering review, or a project may be delayed. This bill would 18 put all capital projects under the review process established by 20 the Department of Administration, Bureau of Public Improvements.
