#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE

An Act to Amend the Schedule of Fees for Plan Review and Issuing of Permits and Approval through the Office of the State Fire Marshal.



#### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

25 MRSA §2450, as repealed and replaced by PL 1983, c. 232, §2, is amended to read:

#### \$2450. Examination by State Fire Marshal

The Commissioner of Public Safety shall, in accordance with requirements of the Maine Administrative Procedure Act, Title 5, chapter 375, adopt a schedule of fees for the examination of all plans for construction, reconstruction or repairs submitted to the Office of the State Fire Marshal. Ne-fee-charged-pursuant-to this-section-may-exceed-\$55. The fees shall must be credited to the State Fire Marshal to defray the expenses of that office. Any balance of the fees shall may not lapse, but shall must be carried forward as a continuing account to be expended for the same purpose in the following fiscal years.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

Current law limits the fee charged by the Office of the State Fire Marshal for the review of construction plans and the issuance of construction permits to \$55. The detailed review of large projects takes days and occasionally weeks. This bill requires the Commissioner of Public Safety to establish a system of fees to recover the costs incurred by the Office of the State Fire Marshal for the review of construction plans and the issuance of the required construction permit.
