**An Act to Require Overtime Pay for Working on Sunday in Certain
Retail Establishments.**

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **26 MRSA §664**, as amended by PL 1987, c. 738, §1, is further
6 amended by adding after the first paragraph a new paragraph to
8 read:

10 Persons operating stores engaged in retail sales of goods
12 shall pay at least 1 1/2 times the regular hourly rate to any
14 employee who works on any Sunday regardless of the total number
16 of hours that the employee worked during the week in which the
18 Sunday work was performed. This provision does not apply to
20 restaurants or other eating establishments.

14 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

16 This bill requires that retail establishments, excluding
18 restaurants, must pay time at a rate of 1 1/2 to an employee who
20 works on Sunday regardless of the number of hours that employee
works during the week.
