40	The bill allowed the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and
42	Wildlife to extend by rule the deer hunting season to the first Saturday in December in any year in which November 30th falls on
44	a Wednesday, Thursday or Friday. This amendment requires that in

any year in which the commissioner by rule extends the season into December, the commissioner must also adopt split seasons for northern and southern zones of the State. In those years, the season must be opened in the northern zone one week earlier than it is opened in the southern zone.
