HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 728, L.D. 1032, Bill, "An Act to Improve the Level of Services Provided by the Bureau of Public Improvements on Capital Improvement Projects"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

This bill allows the Department of Administration, Bureau of Public Improvements, to use 1 1/2% of capital improvement funds to hire project staff or contract for services to provide administrative or supervisory services to those capital projects. The amount available would vary depending on public improvement allocations and bond issues. This will reduce the amount of funding available for construction projects but may also reduce General Fund requests for permanent staff to carry out these responsibilities. The net effect to the General Fund can not be determined at this time.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
