6 2. Beverage container. "Beverage container" means a bottle, can, jar or other container made of glass, metal or plastic which that has been sealed by a manufacturer and which, at-the-time-of-sale, contains one-gallen-or-less-of a beverage.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

14 This bill amends the law concerning returnable containers to include containers regardless of size.
