An Act to Amend the State Government Ethics Laws.



	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	1 MRSA §1016-B, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1989, c. 561, §10,
4	is amended to read:
6	1. Definition. For the purposes of this section,
8	"reportable liability" means any unsecured loan of \$3000 or more received from a person not a relative. "Reportable liability" does not include:
10	A. A credit card liability;
12	B. An educational loan made or guaranteed by a governmental
14	entity, educational institution or nonprofit organization; or
16	C. A loan made from a state or federally regulated financial institution for business purposes.

20	STATEMENT OF FACT
22	This bill excludes certain unsecured loans from disclosure under the ethics laws when the nature of the liability is
24	unlikely to create a potential for a conflict of interest.
