COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 737, L.D. 1041, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Laws Governing the Office of Information Services and the Information Services Policy Board"

Amend the bill in section 4 in subsection 5 in the last 2 lines (page 1, lines 45 and 46 in L.D.) by striking out the underlined words "membership of the board" and inserting in their place the following: 'Executive Department, except that the commissioner of the department in which the Office of Information Services is located is not eligible to chair the board'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The bill required that the chair of the Information Services Policy Board be selected from the membership of the board. This amendment requires that the chair be appointed from within the ranks of the Executive Department. Further, the amendment states that the chair may not be the commissioner of the department in which the Office of Information Services is located.
