STATEMENT OF FACT

This resolve authorizes the Department of Mental Health and
Mental Retardation, through Tri-County Mental Health Services, to
establish a 3-year demonstration crisis intervention program for
children and adolescents in Androscoggin County, Franklin County
and Oxford County. Funding is included for the salaries, fringe
benefits and related expenses of 4 crisis intervention staff for

the first 2 years of the program.

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
