COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 740, L.D. 1044,
"RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine
to Increase the Availability of Legislative Participation"

Amend the resolution in section 2 in the 12th line (page 1,
line 19 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "the effective
date of this paragraph" and inserting in its place the
following: 'November 1, 1991'

Further amend the resolution in section 5 in the 9th and
10th lines (page 1, lines 49 and 50 in L.D.) by striking out the
following: "the effective date of this paragraph" and inserting
in its place the following: 'November 1, 1991'

Further amend the resolution by inserting at the end before
the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The estimated cost of sending this resolution out to
referendum will vary according to the total number of referenda.
The estimated cost to the Secretary of State if one to 6
referenda are enacted is \$95,000. Each additional referendum
costs an additional \$6,500.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment adds a fiscal note to the resolution.
