SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 743, L.D. 1047, Bill, "An Act to Amend and Add to Certain Provisions of Geographic-based Information Services"

Amend the bill in section 6 in that part designated "~~§1753-A.~~" in subsection 1 in the last line (page 2, line 17 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "public;" and inserting in its place the following: 'public. A request to provide the Legislature or an office of the Legislature with existing information for policy decision-making purposes must be considered high priority;'


Further amend the bill in section 6 in that part designated "~~§1753-A.~~" in subsection 5 in the 2nd line (page 2, line 39 in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word "office" the following: ', except that charges may not be levied to the Legislature for existing information'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment provides that the Office of Geographic Information Systems must consider legislative requests as high priority. Charges may not be levied against the Legislature or any office of the Legislature for responses to legislative requests.
