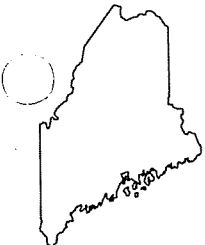

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill broadens the loan authority of the Finance Authority of Maine to include systems installed to improve air quality. The installation of such equipment is required by state law.

The bill eliminates the restriction on the Finance Authority of Maine's underground tank loan program to include any company subject to the air quality requirements. This bill also broadens the authority's loan programs to include air quality improvement equipment.
