Under current law, when a retiree divorces, the retire	ree is
unable to remove the divorced spouse as the retirement su	
benefit beneficiary. This bill allows a retiree to	change
beneficiaries with the agreement of the original spouse,	either
as part of a divorce agreement or at a later time.
