An Act to Allow the Suspension of Fines in Certain Cases.

	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	17-A MRSA §1152, sub-§2, ¶C, as amended by PL 1989, c. 502,

6	C. A fine, suspended in whole or in part,-with-probation-as authorised-by-chapter-49;

12	This bill permits a judge to suspend fines in particular cases without the obligation of the defendant being put on
