An Act to Regulate Cellular Telephone Rates.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2
4 35-A MRS §7306 is enacted to read:

6 §7306. Cellular service rates

8 The commission shall regulate, in accordance with chapter 3,
10 all fees, tolls and other charges levied upon customers by
12 cellular service providers. The commission shall investigate,
pursuant to section 310, any changes proposed by a cellular
service provider of these fees, tolls or other charges,
regardless of the magnitude of the proposed changes.

14 STATEMENT OF FACT

16 This bill requires the Public Utilities Commission to
18 regulate the fees, tolls and other charges levied on customers by
20 cellular service providers. The commission is required to
investigate any proposed changes by a cellular service provider
of its fees, tolls or other charges.
