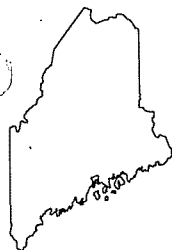

An Act to Require Notice of Costs Associated with Transactions at
Automated Teller Machines.



2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 9-B MRSA §448 is enacted to read:

6 §448. Automated teller machines; notice of cost

8 An automated teller machine owned or operated by a financial
10 institution must give notice to a user for any transaction. The
12 notice must:

14 1. Form. Appear on the display screen of the machine prior
16 to the completion of a transaction; and

18 2. Information. Inform the user of any fee, charge or
20 other cost that will be assessed against the user if the
22 transaction is completed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires that users of automated teller machines be advised of any cost that may be assessed against the user for using the machine.
