An Act to Make Allocations from the Maine Nuclear Emergency Planning Fund for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1992 and June 30, 1993.

(EMERGENCY)

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate until after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and

Whereas, certain obligations and expenses incident to the operation of the Department of Defense and Veterans' Services will become due and payable on or immediately after July 1, 1991; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 37-B MRSA §956, sub-§1, as amended by PL 1989, c. 364, 22 §1, is further amended to read:

Fee. The license holder for any nuclear power reactor operating in this State shall <u>must</u> be assessed a fee of \$200,000
\$130,000 for fiscal year 1988-89 1990-91; \$180,000 for fiscal year 1989-90 1991-92; \$130,000 for fiscal year 1990-91 1992-93; and \$140,000 for fiscal year 1991-92 1993-94 and annually thereafter. License fees shall <u>must</u> be paid to the committee and, upon receipt by it, credited to the fund. The committee may waive all or part of this fee if a reactor is shut down for extended periods of time.

34 Sec. 2. 37-B MRSA §957, as amended by PL 1989, c. 364, §3, is further amended to read:

§957. Disbursements from fund

Money in the fund shall must be disbursed only for the 40 preparation and implementation of emergency planning related to power plants fuel-cycle nuclear and their activities. 42 Expenditures shall must be limited to support of state agency activities, grants to counties, municipalities, 44 interjurisdictional or regional civil emergency preparedness agencies and contractual services necessary to carry out the purposes of this chapter. Except as provided in section 959, . 46 disbursements from the fund may not exceed \$205,035 \$180,000 in fiscal year 1988-89 1990-91; \$222,000 \$200,000 in fiscal year 48 1989-90 1991-92; \$180,000 in fiscal year 1990-91 1992-93; and 50 \$140,000 in fiscal year 1991-92 1993-94 and annually thereafter.
